
Buffalo Transportation Museum

Featuring The Thomas Flyer, Winner of the NY to Paris Race 1908

O'S THOMAS FLYER

Club members arrived on a beautiful warm summer-like day at the Buffalo Transportation Museum. Anticipating new displays every time we go there, we were not disappointed!





The featured vehicle in this summer's display is the original 1908 Thomas Flyer, which won the NY to Paris "Great Race" in 1908. Many stories accompany the car, which John was eager to share with the group. The car itself is indeed the one that made the harrowing trip, as verified by one of the original drivers from WNY. It had been restored to its original glory but it was felt that it should rather be the way it looked after the race. Disney's crew then took it back to 1908, adding dirt, black residue, oil droppings, missing pieces, etc., so that it now is a trip into history!

Many other cars, bicycles, and other items previously manufactured in Buffalo at the Pierce company were on display as well. After the museum we took a short ride to the Hofbrau house for a delicious German lunch. If you didn't get to join us, take a half day to see the unique and valued collection at the BTM. It's a great venue for family and those visiting from out of town to see Buffalo's history.
