

**FULL EVENT SCHEDULE 2024** 



At our September Concours show at Halcyon, we had a unique entry – a **2002 Mercedes-Benz Panzer** owned by **Stephen Muecke**.

This 2002 Mercedes-Benz S-500 was finished in black (040) over matching Charcoal Nappa leather and powered by a 5.0-liter V8 paired with a five-speed automatic transmission. The

M113 5.0-liter V8 was factory-rated at 302 horsepower and 339 lb-ft of torque.

Its equipment includes the M-B Guard Special Protection Vehicle package, which added ballistics-grade polycarbonate glass and high-strength steel body components, B4 certified (up to a .44 Magnum) occupant protection, an armored floor, roof and firewall, and a self-sealing fuel tank. Additional equipment consists of a two-way intercom system, heated and power-adjustable front and rear seats, dual-zone automatic climate control, rear window shades, Parktronic, and an upgraded audio system. This W220 has 27k miles, its service records, factory literature, and the original window sticker (original retail price of \$177,470). *Read More*

M117 Engine Challenges Tech Session Wednesday, January 24, 2024 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM



Gary will discuss what he's learned about the M117 engine while working to fix an irritating drivability problem with a new to him 1973 450SL. This was a car that was rescued by one of our members from sitting outside ignored for many years, and so had no service records and even the mileage was unknown.

Gary comments, "I learned a whole bunch about this engine that I never really wanted to know, but what I learned can be useful to anyone with a car having an M116 or M117 engine, used in many V-8 Mercedes cars from the late '60s until the early 90's. There is a specific set of failures

that can cause engine destruction that anyone with one of these engines needs to be aware of." There will be plenty of time for questions and off topic Mercedes technical questions will be fine, though Gary isn't certain that he will have all the answers.....

This is a repeat of a tech session from March of 2020 which will allow us to record it and get it up on our YouTube channel, MBCA Peachtube.

The tech session will be conducted via Zoom VTC.

### **PERFORMANCE DRIVING 2024**

Now that I'm no longer President, I intend to spend more time on the performance driving program and I wanted to give you a heads up on what to expect for 2024. In short, I want to spin all the plates of performance driving, from defensive driving skills (Safe Driver Safe Family, Urban Survival), karting, autocross, and High Performance Driver Education (HPDE).

For HPDE, we plan a combination of our own events and high-quality events

of partner organizations. We are working on two of our own events this year, one in the Spring probably in April at Talladega Grand Prix Raceway (TGPR) and one on October 7<sup>th</sup> at Atlanta Motorsports Park (AMP) in conjunction with our multi-event weekend. I also encourage you to put May 29<sup>th</sup> on your schedule for a one-day event at Watkins Glen in association with the Lotus club. This is a long way to go, but it's worth it – Watkins Glen is an iconic track and I've gone to this one for the last two years. We'll also plan to go to the local Porsche Club of America (PCA) events at AMP (February 17<sup>th</sup>), and Road Atlanta (June 1/2 and September 27/29). We'll also look at going to a Turn One Performance Driving event at Carolina Motorsports Park – most of their events are on Fridays so we'll try to pick one that makes sense.

As soon as we get the PCA autocross schedule we'll post it on our website events listing and we'll plan to take a groups of Mercedes – we went to a bunch of these several years ago and had great fun. I've been wanting to get back to these; it's a great opportunity to learn low and medium speed car handling skills with low risk.

I'm working on scheduling 3 or 4 karting events at Lanier for 2024 as well. These have been fun and generally well attended. We provide training on how to drive then do four sessions on the track, followed by lunch. This allows wheel to wheel activity that you can't do in any other type of performance driving other than racing.

We also want to do either the AMP Urban Survival Training or the equivalent MBCA event called Safe Driver, Safe Families. I would rather do the Safe Driver Safe Family type event because we can do it ourselves with our own instructors (probably me and Jim Roberts, along with any others we can recruit) and offer it at a much more reasonable price than the AMP Urban Survival Training. The AMP Urban Survival Training has gotten so expensive that I think the price has deterred attendance and last time we didn't have enough participants to meet the minimum for the event. The challenge for the Safe Driver Safe Family event is finding a large enough parking lot at a reasonable price to make it financially viable – we'd like to offer this at a \$50 - \$75 price point. We need about a 200 foot by 300 foot paved area without obstacles to put this on. Let me know if you know of an appropriate parking lot we could use.

This will keep us pretty busy this year, and folks that participate will not only have a lot of fun, they'll learn how to get the most out of their Mercedes and will also become safer drivers! I love to introduce people to performance driving, but I warn you – it's addictive! After one HPDE, I built a race car and spent a decade racing - it just might happen to you....



### **TECHNICAL DIGEST**

R320 (W251) Front End Fun

On the way back from a recent MBCA event, I thought the 2008 R320 CDI 4matic felt a little funny. The car just didn't

feel as solid and secure on the interstate as usual. When we got home, I jacked up the front wheels, checked for play, and finding none, I did a visual inspection of the front shock absorbers. The right front shock showed some fluid leakage, so I ordered a set of shocks. I had earlier detected a CV boot leak on the left front driveshaft, so I had a new driveshaft on hand too and I figured I would address

I put this job off for quite a while because of the amount of disassembly required to get the strut off the car. When I finally got around to starting, I immediately found the real problem. I was checking on the jack placement when I noticed the left front tire had failed. The inner edge of the tread had cracked, and you could see the steel belt in the cracks. I was lucky that the tire didn't blow up on the interstate. The failure was only apparent on the inner edge of the tire, so I had not noticed it previously when I inspected the tires and suspension. *Read more*


After a breakfast on the 17th, we will take a 3-minute walk to the Mercedes-Benz Sprinter Van Dealership for a visit.


