An exciting update to the event.



It's time to get your Benz on the road to prepare it for spring and summer driving around Arizona!! We have the perfect opportunity for you to consider: The M-B.E.A.T., Mike and Bob's Excellent Auto Tour which is planned for Saturday/Sunday April 22/23, 2023. We are dedicating this year's tour to both the late Mike Goodwin who ran the original tour in the Valley for many years, as well as Bob Yoder who continued Mike's drive tradition.

This year the Tour will begin at Denny's Restaurant located behind the 4 Sons Chevron Gas Station at the Northeast corner of Carefree Highway and Interstate 17 at approximately 8:15 with a driver's meeting where each driving team will receive their driving instruction handout. Although still in the final planning stages, so that we can make sure the proposed roads are open, we are likely to follow the traditional route with an initial rest room stop in Wickenburg at Coffinger Park, and then we will continue to Prescott. 

Sponsor Spotlight – Top Shop

We head to Central Phoenix to speak with **Top Shop**, located at 1545 E Indian School Rd (just west of the 51/ exit #3).

Top Shop is a family owned and operated business. It was founded in 1972 by Terry Tapp, and now coowned and operated by Terry and his eldest son James.

Q: Terry and James, what is the main products and services you offer at Top Shop?

Q: Anything else you want our MBCA members to know?


