Bentonville's Historic Peel Museum and Gardens: The Peel Museum, built by Samuel West Peel in 1875 is considered a remarkable example of the Italianate style that was popular in Arkansas from the 1840s to 1890s. It totaled 14 rooms and had two stories plus a basement and tower. The house had eight coal fireplaces. Each one had a distinctive mantelpiece.

Legend says that during their courtship Samuel West Peel promised his wife Mary that he would build her a house like the ones she remembered from her childhood in Alabama. This house is the fulfillment of that promise. The family had two sons and four daughters that lived in the home.



Friday night is always a great time to catch up with friends and enjoy some awesome cars.



Saturday, there were 474 cars on display on the McPherson College campus. The Corvette Club was there to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the brand. MBCA members from Kansas, Arkansas, Missouri and Colorado were in attendance. Some of the keynote cars were a Ferrari 275 GTB, a Talbot-Lago, a Duesenberg, The Ghia "Gilda", and a V-16 Cadillac. Owners from across the United States send these automobiles to McPherson to highlight the quality of the Automobile Restoration program offered by the college.

The General Motors Heritage Center sent three cars from their collection as well as a 2024 Blazer EV prototype. The interior of the Blazer was produced by a graduate of McPherson College, a GM employee who works with the designers and engineers who are working on the vehicles we will see on our roads in the future.

Other cars of interest included a Bugatti EB110, the F40 and 959 and the fire trucks that were on Main Street Friday night plus many brass era and classic automobiles.

The CARS Club Motoring Festival is a chance to see automobiles that have won awards at events like Amelia Island and Pebble Beach, student projects that might be completed by the time they graduate and the cars that supporters of the program display for the enjoyment of all.


