Thank you for your support. Safe driving.





#### EASTERN OKLAHOMA MEMBER INSIGHT

At our annual Benz & Brats event last August, members voted for a new slate of officers. Our new President is Nathan Armer, enthusiastic owner of a red 2006 350 SLK (photo).

I was born and raised in the small town of King City, California in the central coast area. This agricultural valley sported many crop dusters flying most of the year which sparked my airplane interest at age 5. While I was in high school, my family moved to Arkansas. I met my beautiful wife, Robin our senior year of high school. We have been married for over 40 years. After college, we settled in Tulsa to take on our first professional jobs. We have 1 daughter currently working in Pennsylvania.

I retired in late 2020 from a 35-year flying career. Twenty-eight of those years were with 4 airlines accompanied by flight instructing and charter flying. Notable aircraft types I have flown are the Boeing 727, 737, B-17, EMB-145 and DC-3 in addition to light aircraft. My last flight was from Las Vegas to Houston, where I was based. Robin flew down to Houston to meet my last flight (see picture). My total flight time is approximately 24,000 flight hours. I am a former 6-year school board President of a 300-student local private school and an Air Line Pilots Association legislative affairs representative.





My first memory of a Mercedes-Benz automobile was a light yellow 280 SE 4 door from the early 1970s. The car was owned by my 8th grade English teacher Mr. Blach. He showed us kids his new Mercedes-Benz as he beamed with pride. It looked much different from any other car on the road. It appeared well built and just looked like a work of art. It had a stately grill adorned with the "star" emblem. Whenever I saw him drive it, he always wore a suit.

There is another memorable Mercedes-Benz time that I wanted to share. I was a young flight instructor in my first career job. My adult flight student that I was teaching in the late 1980s owned a construction company in Tulsa. He also owned a Mercedes-Benz 560 SL. It was triple black and brand new. One day he called and asked for a favor. Was it possible for me to drive his 560 SL from his hangar and pick him up at a job site? Are you kidding? Of course! Just let me know where to drive it. The keys were in the ignition. The car shined like new. Well, it was new, with just over 1, 000 miles on the odometer. I was engulfed by the rich aroma of leather as I entered the car. It had a solid, but smooth feel and drove like a dream. As I began the drive to the construction site away from Jones/Riverside airport, I slowly passed by 2 of my students outside the flight school. They noticed me as I waved. "Keep studying and maybe someday you'll have a Mercedes too!" I shouted out the window (later, I privately had to admit to those students that the 560 SL did not belong to me). I remember this as if it happened yesterday.

I am looking forward to an exciting year with our MBA Section. If I have not met some of you as of yet, I would like to. May I say it is a pleasure to serve. Many thanks to all of you, my fellow members, and a huge thank you goes to Mr. Blach.
