This club event on June 24 helped us learn about Samuel West Peel, one of the first prominent families settling in Bentonville, Arkansas, in 1875. Samuel and his wife Rose raised seven children on 180 acres with apple orchards, farmland, lush gardens, and the mansion. Helen Walton convinced her husband Sam to save this home and grounds from imminent demolition by investing and restoring the mansion and grounds beginning in 1991, allowing us to marvel at this beautiful time capsule from that period. Many members of the Peel family went on to play a key role across Northwest Arkansas in apples, banking and government leadership. We all learned so much from this free 45-minute guided tour of the Peel House Mansion and Botanical Gardens. This was a great opportunity to gain a perspective and visual of what customs and family life were really like back then.



We closed the afternoon at Lin's Garden Chinese Restaurant, a local favorite with an all-you-can-eat buffet lunch in Bentonville. This is a restaurant to keep on your short list of restaurants for the food quality, service, and value.


#### Annual Membership Recognition Picnic Orchard Park Pavilion, Bentonville, Arkansas July 15, 2023

#### The Great Race Joplin, Missouri Submitted by Bob Poulseen

The Lowingers and Poulseens traveled to Joplin, Missouri, on June 28 to watch the 2023 Great Race participants arrive at the end of a day that began in Russellville, Arkansas. With Joplin being an overnight stop, several blocks in the downtown were designated "The Pits" where the racers were parked, and everyone had an opportunity to look at the cars while they cooled down. This was an opportunity to talk to the driver/navigator teams as they were planning for any maintenance or repair items that needed to be performed. For this event, 1974 cars are the newest that can be entered, and there is a sliding scale of points for the time and distance competition, the older cars earning more "extra credit" based on their age.

Bob and Teresa Poulseen were able to meet with and introduce the Lowingers to a friend from Maine, Philip Reinhardt, who was the navigator of a 1931 REO "ELCO Royale," an open Indianapolis 500-style racer. When asked at the end of the day what the drive had been like, Philip described it as brutal. Philip is a graduate of the Automobile Restoration program at McPherson College and owns a business called Mechanical Arts in Tenants Harbor, Maine; the REO is one of his customer's cars.

There are several classes for the competitors based on experience and success in the race plus a special X-Class for high school and college students. There were three competitors in the Motorcycle class. Racers come from all over the world to participate. Competitors from Finland racing an American LaFrance car had a large support/pit crew all wearing matching uniforms, styling themselves as the Wandering Troubadours of Finland (The true meaning of WTF!).

By the time the racers arrived in Joplin, they had experienced some challenging roads, heavy rain and the heat of summer. And mechanical breakdowns. 120+ had started in Florida, and most were still running. One team had purchased a car on the road when their original car failed to proceed. They could say they finished the race in spite of the obstacles they faced.
