Each of you owns a car from the 8th most recognized brand of any production the world. I recently read an article on the internet about '10 things you might not know about Mercedes-Benz.'

One of those is the excerpt following:

The "Three-Pointed Star" Has Several Meanings

The "three-pointed star" of Mercedes-Benz is one of the most

iconic logos in the world. Even looking outside, the automotive sphere, the Mercedes logo must surely rank right up there as one of the most identifiable. While most of us are familiar with its

design, very few of us understand the origins of the logo.

Legend has it that Gottlieb Daimler sent his sons a postcard in 1872, and a three-pointed star was used to indicate the location

of their home. The brothers used this as the basis of the

Mercedes-Benz logo, developing it from the blue originally used to the silver design we are now familiar with. Each point is said to represent land, sea, and air, the environments that the company wanted to conquer. The final piece of the puzzle relates to the circle in which the star is housed. Added in 1926, it marked the merger of Daimler and Mercedes-Benz.

Your club represents the value you put into your car. Members can communicate how they care for their car and find hints of where to find repairs or service, how to fix it yourself and how to exhibit your passion at a show, on a track or driving down the street.

MBCA is currently evaluating what our future will look like. Some areas of the country have events focused on their surroundings and may not venture to a long-distance event like Mercedes Grande. But once there, they find a wide spectrum of ways to enjoy your automobile. 
August 12-13, 2023 * With the Houton Section, College Station, TX

Special Report

Silver Star Preservation



Most car show aficionados know that all concours are now recognizing original untouched and non-restored cars for special awards. For example, Pebble Beach, the grand-daddy of all Concours has a special classification known as the "Preservation Class" and presents awards to Pre-War and Post-War cars. Many other Concours have followed their lead. Today the preservation class is one of the most popular classifications at major and even regional and local shows around the world.

This class is for cars, 25 years old or older that are largely original and have been unrestored since new. It is intended

for driver- quality cars that have withstood the ravages of time, climate and daily driving.

This classification is designed to formally recognize original cars that meet the defined

set of standards by presenting the owner with a certificate commemorating the event and displaying a photo and pertinent data, suitable for framing. It can also add to the provenance of your car whenever one intends to sell or insure it.

How It Works

Your eligible Mercedes-Benz must be entered in a MBCA sanctioned sectional, regional or national concours. To be eligible, the vehicle must be at least 25 years old and it should be in good working order, driven under its own power to the event and be largely original. Your eligible



car should have an original engine and drivetrain. There can be partial refurbishments of various components, but no complete restorations can be accepted.

To self-judge your car prior to having it reviewed and processed by the judge at the show event, go to https://www.mbca.org/enthusiasts/resources and print the form and complete it. Bring to the show. The judge will review the document, confirm your car and take a picture of you and your car for submission to the Chief Judge.


