


Enid Car Show and Collection When: Saturday, April 13th Where: Enid, OK

The local community rolled out the red carpet to celebrate the release of a documentary, "The Road to Pebble Beach", which chronicled the multi-year effort of the students of McPherson College to restore a 1953 Mercedes 300S Cabriolet and bring it to the prestigious car show at Pebble Beach. The Wichita Section met up at Mark Arts to attend this event. Along with watching the film, which was narrated by Jay Leno, this was an opportunity to also ask questions of some of the students involved in the restoration of the vehicle. Additionally, the car itself was on display, along with a lot of background information on the vehicle. All in all, it was a very classy event!









Let Me Tell You About My Car....

My Wife's Daily Driver - by Jim Doody

We took delivery of our 2014 Mercedes GLK-250 4-Matic, from Mercedes Benz Canada, in November 2013, in Calgary, Alberta. This was our first diesel car, and we equipped it with leather seats, upgraded stereo, and bi-zenon headlights. After our first year, we upgraded to snow tires, to get through the Calgary winters. We started using Redline oil, which is ester based, and very good at high temperatures. One of the British mechanics that I followed had recommended the esterbased oil to deal with the



common lube oil system for the engine with twin turbos. The turbochargers can run very hot and tend to degrade the shared engine oil. The ester-based oil stands up well over time but is more expensive. This car was equipped with environmental controls and a diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) tank. Within the first year, we started having problems with these controls, especially the 10 starts remaining count down timer. Once this alarm was triggered, you would have just 10 more starts and the car would lock out. We had many trips back to the dealership, to have the vehicle reset. Unfortunately, the dealer was unable to repair this issue, so we wrote the President of Mercedes Benz Canada. He couldn't help either, as he is a marketing / sales guy, and not a mechanic. At this stage, my wife was ready to sell the car for a dollar, due to her frustration with service. In order to keep the car in use, I hired a tuner to disconnect the emission control system. We chose ECU Program, of Calgary, for these tuning services. For \$1,000 CDN (\$758 US), they disconnected the DEF tank and the emissions system. The work was done professionally, and we have been happy with the performance ever since. The disadvantage of this tune is that we will never be able to register this vehicle in the State of California. Our GLK-250 now has 86,000 km (53,320 miles) on the odometer. I'm very happy with the tuned version of the GLK-250 and wouldn't hesitate to buy another one on the used market now that I know the car. We use the services of a monthly car wash, keeping the mats, interior and exterior clean. This vehicle has been garaged since it was new.
