


MBCA WEBSITE UPDATE

This foundation on automation allowed their HOA managers to spend time where it counts, with the Boards and Homeowners.

This customer service philosophy started by doing simple things, like answering the phone, not utilizing a phone auto-attendant and taking care of Homeowners issues on the first call, radical ideas in the HOA management world.

As the company grew, they "Focused" on the needs of the HOA, both operation and financial. Using an allinclusive cost model made the business more efficient and saved the HOAs money. Including in their service items like:

- All late fees go to the Association not the management company.
- Community Web Site Homeowners have access to all their account information on-line.
- Web based system giving the Board access to real time reports and all Association files.
- No charge for internal office supplies or banking services.

They developed financial tools for the Board for operational and reserve budgeting projecting 30-year cash flows to allow them to plan the HOA's financial health for the long them and make sure they are operating efficiently as possible.




