I think events are the essence of our club, and you can't do events without event planners - this is really important to me and to the club.

Refunds.

An event planner asked me recently for guidance on issuing refunds. Our policy is generally that event planners are fully responsible for all aspects of their events and it's their decision whether to issue a refund or not – after all, they're the ones who best know the event financials. My thoughts are that we should give refunds whenever reasonable. This generally means to me that if a person cancels before the club has expended funds on their behalf, we should allow a refund. If funds have been expended and can't be recovered, then it isn't prudent to refund fees. In all cases, though, if you have registered for an event and have found out you can't attend, contact the registrar/event planner as soon as possible – some events have minimum required numbers – and if there is any chance of recovering some money, earlier notification makes it more likely.

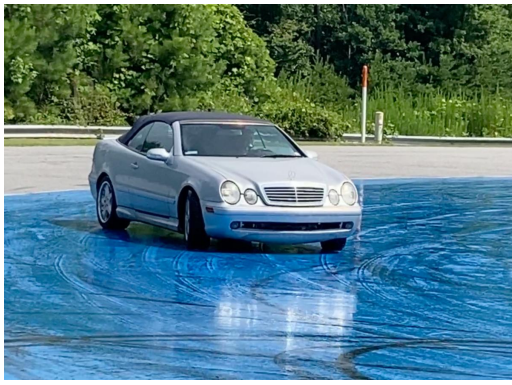

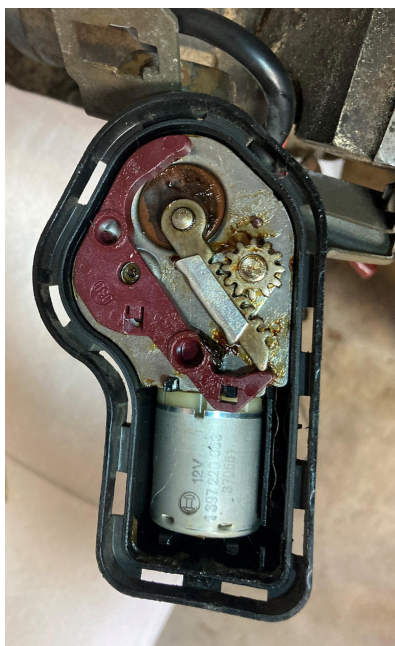

Technical Digest

Headlight Washer Woes

One of the unusual features of some older Mercedes are the headlight wipers/washer systems. It's one of the features that makes these cars unique, but it's also a bit quirky and prone to odd failures. I'm referring to the systems on some W124 and R129 cars, and others, with a wiper and sprayer system. Many people give up on these systems when they misbehave, but I like for things to work as intended.

When working properly, the system will function when you have the lights on and you activate the windshield washer. The headlight wipers will sweep and spray cleaning fluid (from the windshield washer reservoir, heated if necessary) just in front of the wiper blade (the sprayer is in the blade). [Read more](#)
