

This month, I want to talk about membership, demographics and performance driving.

First, the performance driving – as this newsletter goes out, we are within two weeks of our track event, MBCA Performance Driving at Talladega Gran Prix Raceway on June 11th. If you haven't already signed up, this is an excellent opportunity to learn driving skills to better use your car's capabilities, plus you'll have fun too! We also need enough participants to pay for this event so I encourage you to support our program and sign up (see

my "Reduce My Stress Level" comments in a previous article). If you aren't quite sure whether you're ready for track driving, we are also offering the Performance Driving Experience, at reduced cost, which offers the classroom instruction, and highway speed track sessions, one with you driven by an instructor and one with you driving with the instructor in the passenger seat. One other pertinent aspect of performance driving is emergency handling and skid recovery. We'll be working on that at our Performance Driving Urban Survival Training on July 24th. This is a one-day event at Atlanta Motorsports Park where we'll practice ABS braking, braking while turning, autocross skills plus skid initiation and recovery using their newly repaved wet skid pad and ice hill. You'll probably save the entry fee due to reduced insurance costs that most companies will give when you show them your completion certificate. Grab a navigator and join us on June 25th for a leisurely drive along the country roads



<u>CLK55 (M113 engine) Water Pump</u> and Radiator Replacement

I have a couple of high mileage W208 CLK55s and I've recently had to replace two radiators and a water pump in these cars. The work is relatively straightforward with some unique features and is well within the capabilities of the hobbyist.

These were the second and third radiator failures I had seen recently and they were all the same failure mode – a leak between the aluminum core and the left side plastic tank. Unique in my experience, the radiator comes out the top after removing the crossmember above the radiator. You do still have to go under the car to drain the coolant and remove the hoses, but the job just isn't that bad. I did manage to break the plastic fan shroud when replacing it (it's just not that flexible and it can be a little challenging to fit it into place). One other difficulty; the transmission cooler fittings are on the front of the radiator and the lower one is inaccessible with the radiator in position. It is necessary to pull the top of the radiator to the rear to access this fitting *Read more*


Drive to Bell Mountain - May 21, 2022




